



Agreement to Receive Periodic Statements Electronically

TLC Community Credit Union

This disclosure governs, along with any other documents applicable to this account including the Credit Union's Electronic Funds Transfer Agreement and Membership Account Agreement, the agreement between the member and TLC Community Credit Union regarding receiving periodic statements electronically. The member acknowledges that printed periodic statements will no longer be mailed to the member. If, at any time, the member decides that he/she no longer wants to receive the periodic statement(s) electronically and wants to resume receiving a printed copy of the periodic statements, you understand that you can withdraw your consent at any time by making the appropriate choices on the Settings->Statement Preferences, found under the Options menu in Home Banking.

You agree to provide and maintain a valid, active e-mail address. You may update your e-mail address from the Options menu in Home Banking at any time. TLC Community Credit Union is not liable for any third-party incurred fees, other legal liability, or any other issues or liabilities arising from statements or notifications sent to an invalid or inactive e-mail address that you have provided.

The periodic statement(s) will be available through the Home Banking system via the Internet. An electronic mail (e-mail) notification will be sent to the address on file for the primary member when the statement(s) are available for viewing. The member who receives this e-mail is the agent for his/her joint owners for the purpose of receiving and notifying them that the statement(s) is available. The member must notify the Credit Union within 60-days after receiving the e-mail notification of any discrepancies. If the member fails to notify the Credit Union, the member will have no claim against the Credit Union. However, if the discrepancy is the result of an electronic funds transfer, the provisions of the Credit Union's Electronic Funds Transfer Agreement will control this resolution. The member agrees that the Credit Union is not liable to the member if the member is unable to access the e-mail site or download the statement to a printer.

I understand that my periodic statement(s) will no longer be sent to me by U.S. Mail and that I will need access to the Home Banking system via the Internet, an e-mail account and Adobe Acrobat reader software in order to have access to my statement(s) electronically. (Adobe Acrobat reader software is available to download from www.adobe.com).

It is recommended that you print a copy of any electronically provided statements or disclosures (including this one) for your records.
