



Agreement to Receive Periodic Statements Electronically

This disclosure governs, along with any other documents applicable to this account including the Credit Union's Electronic Funds Transfer Agreement and Membership Account Agreement, the agreement between the member (you) and TLC Community Credit Union regarding receiving periodic statements electronically. You acknowledge that printed periodic statements will no longer be mailed to you at your address on record. If, at any time, you decide that you no longer want to receive the periodic statement(s) electronically and want to resume receiving a printed copy of the periodic statements, you understand that you can withdraw your consent at any time by making the appropriate choices on the Settings->Statement Preferences, found under the Options menu in Online Banking.

You agree to provide and maintain a valid, active e-mail address. You may update your e-mail address from the Options menu in Online Banking at any time, and your change will take effect a reasonable time thereafter. TLC Community Credit Union is not liable for any third-party incurred fees, other legal liability, or any other issues or liabilities arising from statements or notifications sent to an invalid or inactive e-mail address that you have provided.

The periodic statement(s) will be available through the Online Account Access system via the Internet. An electronic mail (e-mail) notification will be sent to the email address on file for the primary member when the notices and statement(s) are available for viewing. The member who receives this e-mail is the agent for his/her joint owners for the purpose of receiving and notifying them that the statement(s) is available. You must notify the Credit Union within 60-days after receiving the e-mail notification of any discrepancies. If you fail to notify the Credit Union, you will have no claim against the Credit Union. However, if the discrepancy is the result of an electronic funds transfer, the provisions of the Credit Union's Electronic Funds Transfer Agreement will control this resolution. You agree that the Credit Union is not liable if you are unable to access the e-mail site or download the statement to a printer.
